



Permission to Travel within the USA (for Minors)

Minors under the age of 18 traveling within the United State, when not accompanied on the trip by parent(s), must have a notarized affidavit from the parent(s) not accompanying the child that:

1. The child is traveling within the United States with the permission of the parent(s).
2. That the non-traveling parent(s) is aware that the child is leaving on the departure date, and
3. The name(s) of the person(s) accompanying the child.

If the minor child is leaving the country without either of his/her parent(s), both parent(s) must provide a notarized signed affidavit as outlined.

A parent must sign the permission form, which **MUST** be notarized. If the parents are not together, parent consent from one of the parents is necessary but not by both parents.
