To everyone who bought, sold, and savored our cookies — THANK YOU. You make it all possible. 💚

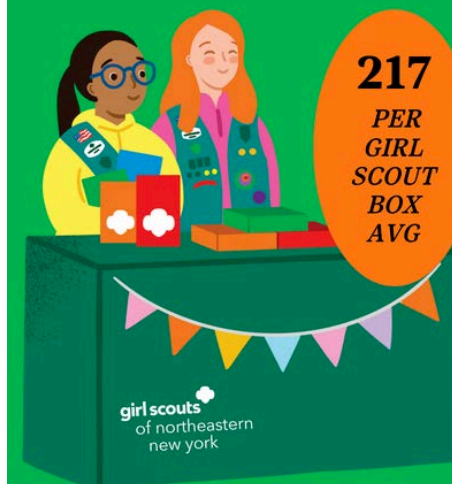
