<u>Mental Health Conversation Starters</u>

Asking someone about their emotional or mental wellness can be awkward. How will they respond? What if they don't want to talk about it? What if they end up getting upset with me? Most people were raised to consider discussions about mental health as intrusive, taboo, or even shameful. As our society continues to recognize that good mental health is part of overall health and wellness, we see more and more people talking openly and honestly about their mental health and well-being. A recent report found that over 80% of teens want more honest conversations about mental health. To help caregivers and other caring adults (like our volunteers) start a conversation about youth emotional wellbeing, the School Mental Health Resource and Training Center at MHANYS has created a Mental Health Conversation Starters toolkit that provides sample prompts for a variety of situations or concerns as well as tips on how to discuss good mental health habits and how to create a safe, caring and age-appropriate atmosphere for ongoing conversation and dialogue with young people.
