



Yes, Your Daughter Just Called Herself Fat



"I'm fat." Those are just two little words, five letters in total, but coming from your daughter, they're enough to make your heart totally sink. How could a girl who's typically so kind and accepting of others be so disparaging of herself? According to studies, a whopping 80 percent of 10-year-olds are afraid of being fat.

Why? Because they're constantly surrounded by both subtle and direct messages that curvier or heavier girls aren't as well liked, aren't as likely to succeed in business, and in general, aren't going to have as much fun or happiness in their lives. So, when your daughter does call herself fat, as her parent your instinct might be to immediately brush off her concerns by saying something like, "Don't be silly! You're beautiful!" The thing is, though, that response might actually do more harm than good says Girl Scouts' Developmental Psychologist, Dr. Andrea Bastiani Archibald. Heres what to do instead <u>READ MORE</u>


