## **Bling Your Booth**



**Renewals Start April 1st!** 

Girls and Adults who renew for MY 26 are eligible for renewal awards! \*Council wide eligibility, not divided by region.

Patches and folios available for pickup at the Volunteer Appreciation Dinner, 4/25/25.

Parties and Experience rewards must be used by 4/1/26.

To be eligible for the troop renewal incentive, troop must contain two registered adults (with background checks) plus 5 registered girls, exceptions can be made for Senior/Ambassador Troops.
