### Training Opportunity for Adults and older Girl Scouts!



Talk Saves Lives is an education program of the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention that provides participants with a clear understanding of this leading cause of death, including the most up-to-date research on suicide prevention, and what they can do in their communities to save lives.

Participants will learn common risk factors and warning signs associated with suicide, and how to keep themselves and others safe.



Topics covered include:

Scope of the Problem: The latest data on suicide in the U.S. and worldwide



Research: Information from research on what causes people to consider suicide, as well as health, historical, and environmental factors that put individuals at risk

Prevention: An understanding of the protective factors that lower suicide risk, and strategies for managing mental health and being proactive about self-care

What You Can Do: Guidance on warning signs and behaviors to look for, and how to get help for someone in a suicidal crisis

As Girl Scouts engage in the Cookie Program, they learn five valuable skills that will serve them for the rest of their lives.



# **Fundraising Ban Lifted**



GSUSA Fundraising Ban Lifted to Support Those Impacted by the Israel-Gaza War

Per the Blue Book, the governing document for Girl Scouts of the USA, members may not raise money for other organizations. That fundraising ban has been temporarily lifted to support those affected by the Israel-Gaza War by National CEO Bonnie Barczykowski and National President Noorain Khan. Girl Scouts may raise funds through June 4, 2024. It is recommended that contributions be made to charities that have been identified by <a href="https://www.charity.com/CharityWatch">Charity Watch</a>.
