

Practice Self-Care with Mental Wellness Patch Programs

Designed for Girl Scouts in 4th to 12th grades, the Mental Wellness patch programs help youth learn about self-care, build healthy habits, safely explore their feelings, and to seek support and resources in a safe setting. From learning about their emotions (Knowing My Emotions, Juniors), to advocating for themselves (Finding My Voice, Cadettes), and learning to cope with difficult situations (Showing Up For Me and You, Seniors and Ambassadors), Girl Scouts gain the confidence to show their strength. They learn what mental health is, how to combat stigma, and how to take care of their own wellbeing as they navigate today's complex and challenging world. 

Per the Blue Book, the governing document for Girl Scouts of the USA, members may not raise money for other organizations. That fundraising ban has been temporarily lifted to support those affected by the Israel-Gaza Conflict by National CEO Bonnie Barczykowski and National President Noorain Khan. Girl Scouts may raise funds through June 4, 2024. It is recommended that contributions be made to charities that have been identified by Charity Watch.
