Renewal Incentives 2025-2026

To Earn Troop Renewal Incentive:

Troops who reach or exceed 90% of their MY 2025 girl number (by renewing current members or signing up new ones) by June 30th.

To be eligible for the troop renewal incentive, troop must contain two registered adults

(with background checks) plus 5 registered girls, exceptions can be made for Senior/Ambassador Troops.

GSNENY Council will count memberships on April 1; this is the number used to calculate the percentage for renewals on July 1. Percentages calculated include renewing members and new members after April 1.





Raise Her to Be a STEMinist

When it comes to science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) fields, women make up less than a quarter of the workforce. Considering roughly 80 percent of mid-level jobs—including jobs that don't require a college degree—involve STEM skills, we need to catch girls up, quickly.

What can you do about it? "Not every girl is going to want to pursue a career in STEM, and it's important to encourage her to follow her own passions," says Girl Scouts' developmental



psychologist Dr. Andrea Bastiani Archibald, "but every girl should be encouraged to try her hand at STEM skills, get comfortable with those concepts, and learn how they apply to all kinds of surprising fields—from fashion to finance, and beyond." Payments and Paperwork

- June 17th: all camper paperwork and camp balances due.
- Camps remain open for additional enrollment (subject to availability) until Friday afternoon, two weeks prior to their start date.

Camp Is-Sho-Da Buses, Overnights and Campfires

- Bus routes with insufficient registration may be cancelled or modified based on enrollment by June 1st. If your camper needs bus transportation, please register soon.
- Buses remain open for additional enrollment until 10am the Wednesday before each camp session begins. Register on our website.
