

Renewal Incentives 2025-2026

To Earn Troop Renewal Incentive:

Troops who reach or exceed 90% of their MY 2025 girl number (by renewing current members or signing up new ones) by June 30th.

To be eligible for the troop renewal incentive, troop must contain two registered adults

(with background checks) plus 5 registered girls, exceptions can be made for Senior/Ambassador Troops.

GSNENY Council will count memberships on April 1; this is the number used to calculate the percentage for renewals on July 1. Percentages calculated include renewing members and new members after April 1.


*Troop must contain two registered adults (with background checks) plus 5 registered girls. Exceptions may be available for Senior/Ambassador troops regarding girl numbers.

Troop Finance Reports

All troops are required to submit an annual Troop Financial Report using the Volunteer Toolkit (VTK) by July 20th of each year.



- Requires a submission of the June bank statement.
- Submission window is June 1st-July 20th
- The online submission process is accessed through the VTK
- Troop Financial Volunteer can update balances as the year progresses, as well as edit bank account details.
- Parents can view the financial report at any time, but cannot make edits.
- Line items will not be calculated until the final summary
- GSUSA will send you a copy of your report after submission.





Talking to Children About War

International wars and conflicts enhance our sense of danger and may cause worry about what will happen in the days and weeks ahead. A range of emotions (e.g., outrage, fear, anxiety and sorrow) are common and can change as the situation evolves. They can create safety concerns for the region that reach into our own country. Some families may be worried about loved ones who are directly impacted, including those who live in the area; those who were visiting and are trying to get back to the United States; or those who are deployed as part of the military, government, or a relief organization. Parents and caregivers can help children navigate what they are seeing and hearing by having a conversation with them, acknowledging their feelings, and finding ways to cope together. This Resource from the National Child Traumatic Stress Network may be a useful tool for supporting those conversations.
