



Bad Day? Tell Your Daughter About It!

Ever had a day when absolutely nothing seemed to go right? We've all been there. Yet so often, when asked the seemingly simple question, "How was your day?" you likely tend to respond by telling people everything's fine—regardless of how hairy things have been. But that's exactly what you shouldn't do when it comes to your daughter. In fact, you should make a point to talk to her—in an age-appropriate way, of course—about the annoyances, disappointments, and other general crud in your day!

"Challenges and failures are a normal part of life," says Girl Scouts' Developmental Psychologist Dr. Andrea Bastiani Archibald. "And as parents and caregivers, it's important to raise our children—especially girls, who are so often steered away from negative feelings like anger, sadness, or frustration—to understand these experiences are to be expected, and negative emotions often totally appropriate. She needs to know it's OK and important to talk about them with the people we trust." READ MORE
