

Fundraising Ban Lifted



GSUSA Fundraising Ban Lifted to Support Those Impacted by the Israel-Gaza Conflict

Per the Blue Book, the governing document for Girl Scouts of the USA, members may not raise money for other organizations. That fundraising ban has been temporarily lifted in two cases to support people in need. Girl Scouts may raise money for those affected by the Israel-Gaza Conflict through September 5th, 2024 and those impacted by the New Mexico Wildfires through September 27th, 2024. It is recommended that contributions be made to charities that have been identified by Charity Watch.

GSNENY troops, service units, or individual Girl Scouts interested in fundraising must first receive Council approval and agree to comply with fundraising rules by completing the Activity Funding Request form HERE
