

Don't Like Her Look? Get Over It

"Your girl is starting to develop her own identity, and fashion and style are a creative way for her to express her individuality and interests," says Girl Scouts'

Developmental Psychologist, Dr. Andrea Bastiani

Archibald. "When you dictate what she can and cannot wear based on what you like and don't, you're stifling her self-expression, which can affect her ability to make friends and connect with other like-minded kids." Beyond that, it's important to keep in mind that many middle and high school age girls already feel self-conscious about their looks, and giving them the freedom to express themselves through clothing they feel good in can boost their confidence. Peace of mind: A will allows you to provide for the people you love, so they will always be supported.




