

Vote for Girl Scouts x NAMI Panel at SXSW EDU 2025 by August 18

GSUSA has submitted a panel for SXSW EDU, an annual event held in Austin, Texas, that hosts a variety of sessions, workshops, and networking opportunities within the education sector. If selected, GSUSA's panel will feature Bonnie Barczykowski, Dr. Christine Crawford, medical director at the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI), and Gold Award Girl Scouts to discuss mental health topics affecting girls today.

To be selected, the panel must obtain enough community votes, as they make up 30 percent of the final programming decision. Voting opens Tuesday, August 6, and ends Sunday, August 18. Peace of mind: A will allows you to provide for the people you love, so they will always be supported.


Impact
